 this is by creating gift guides.
- Create a list of local community service facilities and neighborhood development supported by your CDFI and others in your region with a suggested walking or driving itinerary that new staff can follow to better understand the people and places your CDFI serves.
- Attend in-person industry events: Appendix B of the CDFI 101 Guide (on p.21) provides a starting point with a list of annual in-person events and forums.
- <u>Sign-up for OFN emails and newsletters</u> to stay informed on industry news, as well as OFN resources, trainings, and events including webinars, regional meetings, forums, and our annual conference!
